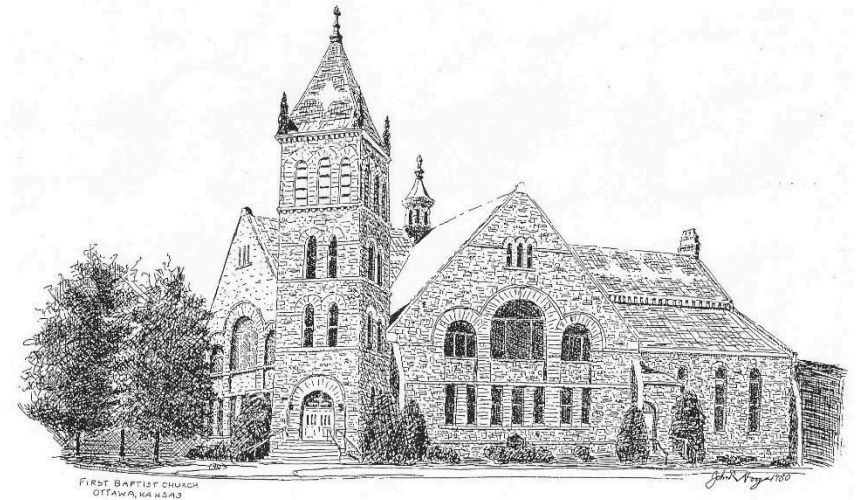
ABWM
