ABWM Book of the Month **REVELATION**

Revelation 1:1 "....God gave Jesus Christ the revelation to show his servants what must soon take place. He sent his angel to John, who testified to everything he saw-the word of God and the testimony of Jesus Christ.

John wrote all he saw and was told. The story resembles something out of science fiction imagination. Pay attention to cross references and footnotes in your study bible. The imagery of Revelation 2:17 "hidden Manna" the bread from heaven for the Israelites is a symbolic picture of Jesus Christ; "white stone with a new name written on it", symbol of a reward from God.

John had witnessed the seven churches in Asia Minor, Jesus sent His angel to John to dictate letters to the churches. Each letter began with a praise BUT then a warning. All letters end with, "He who has an ear, let him hear what the Spirit says to the churches.....and more......."

Revelation 12:10

- v. 12:10 Then I heard a loud voice in heaven (u) say: "Now have come the salvation and the power and the kingdom of our God, and authority of his Messiah. For the accuser of our brothers (v) and sisters. Who accuses them before our God has been thrown down.
- (u) Rev. 11:15 "The seventh angel sounded his trumpet, and there were loud voices in heaven.."
- (v) Job 1:9-11 Is God and Satan's conversation.

Zechariah 3:1 Satan presents Joshua to God tattling on him of sinning. God showers Joshua with Grace. Victory over Satan. Satan's freedom to visit heaven is coming to a close. **Footnote:**

12:10 Death and resurrection of Christ is the basis for all victory over Satan. Therefore, children of God need not fear the ultimate death-separation from Him (also referred to as "the second death" 20:6)-for their salvation is secure.

Mobile Clinics in Rural India Provide Much-Needed Care and Awareness

Access to medical care is one way to spread hope and provide people with the needed tools to improve their physical well-being. Many rural communities in the hills and villages of northeastern India do not have this kind of access. Children suffer from malnutrition and other preventable diseases because there is a lack of training and awareness about health issues.
