There will be no fellowship today. The office will be closed on Monday September 2nd.

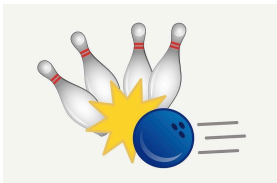


FBC Library

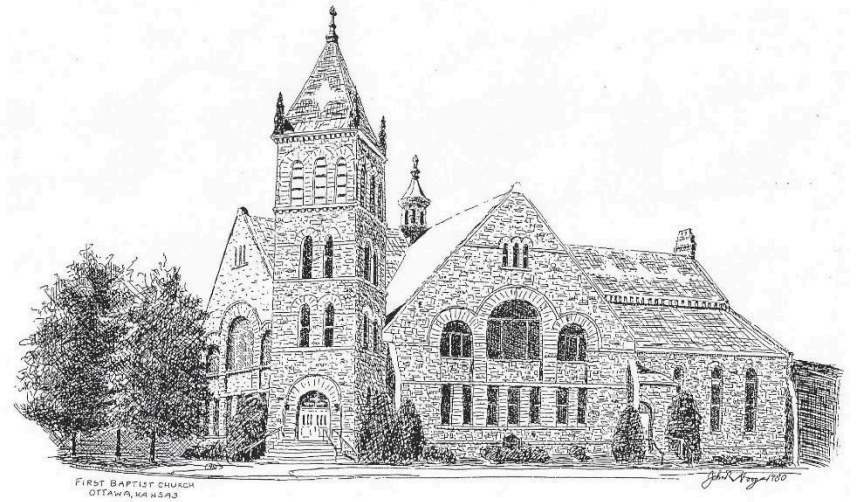
Carolyn Kimbrel is actively working in the library as we have new books coming in. Please come in to find some new books to read this fall.
